

Prof Arijit Mukhopadhyay is a researcher in human genetics since 1999. He has been a Principal Investigator leading a research group on genetic basis for human diseases since 2007 and have worked across different countries and continents. He has supervised 16 PhD students to completion and has published over 70 peer reviewed articles in international journals (>3100 citations; h-index 31). A major part of Prof Mukhopadhyay's career is focused on genetics of eye diseases – especially glaucoma. He and his colleagues were the first to report the genetic basis of primary open angle glaucoma from India. He has taken major initiatives on public outreach and awareness about genetic basis of glaucoma and the benefits of Genetic Counselling.
